

Warranty Claims


1.Warranty is not transferable.







Installation instructions

Filtration installation


Insert filter mesh into the bottom of machine and twist clockwise, tighten filter mesh.





Removal filter mesh

From the bottom of machine, twist counterclockwise, rotate and pull out the filter mesh.



How to use

Power on: The buzzer sounds once after the machine is powered on, and the power indicator lights red and enters into standby state.

After the power button is turned on, the machine enters the Power operating mode, and automatically turns on the negative ion and UV lamp functions, and the machine works in the second gear

After pressing the wind speed key, the display shows 1, 2, 3, 4, Speed: (cycle), the first time the key is pressed, the current gear will be displayed. After pressing the second time, the gear is adjusted.

Press and hold the "WIFI" button for 5 seconds in the power-on

Touch the timing, the digital display panel displays 1-8 hours cycle, long press for two seconds to cancel the timing. After canceling the timing function, the timing icon will not light up, and the digital tube will display the current gear position.

The negative ion button is to switch the negative ion function, and the icon will be highlighted when the negative ion function is turned on. The icon is half bright when the negative ion is off. $\Theta \overline{\Theta}$

UV light: UV

The UV button is to switch the UV function. When the function is turned on, the height of the button icon is turned off. When the button icon is half-lit.

Filter reset: When the filter replacement icon flashes white slowly, you need to replace the filter. Press and hold the filter reset button for 3 A seconds and then restart the timer (1500 hours).

Mode: After pressing the mode button, switch to "Sleep mode, ____ Auto mode. Turbo mode" ____ _

In Sleep mode, the sleep icon is on and the rest of the icons are off. In any case, press any button to wake up the button lights and Sleep: display, and then press the wind speed button/mode button/off button to exit the sleep mode.

In Auto mode, the extreme speed icon lights up to limit the working Auto: time for 2H, and then jump to the automatic mode.

In Turbo mode, the automatic icon lights up, when the PM2.5 data is lower than 20 and continuesAfter 10 minutes, the machine Turbo: automatically enters sleep mode, when the sensor data is higher than 50The machine automatically exits sleep mode. (This function is invalid in non-automatic mode)

Filter maintenance

1.Pre-filter+hepa +carbon 3-in-1 Filter



When the machine is timed to 1,500 hours, the button icon slowly flashes white light, the icon 🔱 prompts the user to replace the filter mash. Press this button for 3 seconds to reset the replacement prompt. (The filter mash replacement prompt function is reset, not the current accumulated time. After reset, the time will be increased upwards, and it will be prompted for replacement after the next 1,500 hours)

• Place the filter in a ventilated place so that the harmful gases and bacteria on the surface of the filter can be volatilized. Do not expose it to excessive sunlight. · Do not wash the filter with water.

- Unplug the power plug before cleaning and maintenance; • Do not operate with the filter removed (no dust removal effect, and the dust that is
- inhaled may cause equipment failure);
- Unplug the power cord when it is idle for a long time (it will also consume power in the standby state):
- Depending on the place of use and the method of use (for example, households with a large number of smokers or areas with severe air pollution), the filter replacement cycle may be shortened. If the filtration effect is not obvious, replace the filter in time.
- When replacing the filter, please turn off the power first.

Precautions

Installation instructions

1.Do not place in the following places: sunlight

•Direct sunlight or facing the air outlet and heated places (may cause deformation, Deterioration, discoloration, and failure). •Equipment accessories such as TVs and radios (which may cause image distortion and noise). Please place it at a distance of 1m or more. At the same time, if the same socket is used with these devices, image plugging and noise may occur when the power plug is inserted.

When this happens, plug the power cord into a different outlet.

2. For indoor dust such as pollen, the product should be placed on the ground. Since pollen, dust, etc. are likely to fall near the floor, it is recommended to place the product on a flat floor in the room.

3.In order to effectively circulate the air in the room. In order not to block the air inlet and outlet, place the product about 30cm or more from the left and right sides of the wall, furniture, curtains, etc. In order to use this product more effectively, please keep the back of the product at least 20cm away from the wall.

4.Do not place objects on the main unit (otherwise it may cause the machine to malfunction). Special Note: Do not place magnets and metal objects.

5.Do not block the air inlet and outlet, for example, do not place objects on the air outlet. Or in front of the air inlet.


Warning

Prohibited

- 1. The machine is prohibited from moving or shaking while it is running. Do not pull on the power cord while moving or storing it. Pulling the power cord may cause a short circuit or damage to the inside of the power cord, resulting in fire or electric shock.
- 2.Do not damage the power cord or plug, and do not cut, excessively twist, pull, or twist the power cord. If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, service department or professional to avoid danger. Non-professionals are prohibited from disassembling the machine to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- 3. The plug and hand should not be exposed to water before plugging in the power plug, otherwise there is a danger of electric shock.

· · · 4.Do not use power supplies, universal sockets or connected devices that exceed the rated value.24V power adapter. Using a universal outlet that exceeds the rated value or connecting the ^{24V power adapter} power supply may cause the power cord to overheat and cause a fire

- 5.Do not touch the power plug with wet hands, which may result in electric shock.
- 6.Do not put your fingers or metal objects into the gap of the air outlet, otherwise it may cause electric shock or injury. Do not allow water, flammable detergents or other liquids to enter the product to avoid electric shock or fire.
- 7. This product is not a substitute for normal ventilation equipment daily vacuum cleaners and range hoods used in the kitchen.
- 8.Do not use this product in gas appliances, heating devices or stove accessories.
- 9.Do not use this product in a wet or hot environment such as a bathroom, toilet or kitchen.
- 10.Never place products in such locations
- Unstable locations (otherwise the product may fall or fall over. resulting in injury, electric leakage, electric shock or fire.)
- Locations that are hot, humid, or wet, such as bathrooms (air purifiers may cause electric shock or fire due to electric leakage. a place where the kitchen emits soot

Mandatory matters

- 1. Turn off the power of the machine immediately when any of the following conditions occur (may cause electric shock, sparks or smoke)
- There is abnormal sound or vibration during operation.
- •The product is abnormally hot and has a burnt odor.

2.Please clean the power plug regularly

- If the power plug is dusty, moisture may damage the insulated part of the plug, resulting in a fire.
- If the appliance is not used for a long time, please unplug the power cord.

3.Be sure to disconnect the power before performing maintenance on the appliance.

- The product may suddenly start, causing electric shock and injury.
- 4.Plug the plug securely into the power outlet (if the plug is not securely inserted, it may cause electric shock due to overheating or even cause a fire.) • Do not use a damaged plug or a loose power outlet.
